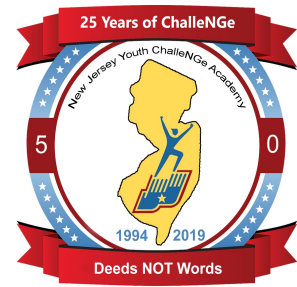




# BIOGRAPHY
